## Verifone XL \& Tranz Series Time \& Date Change

First determine which Chip Version you have. First press the[3] and the [*] keys at the same time. The terminal will then display DIAGNOSTICS. Press the [ALPHA] key. If the terminal displays: "YEAR=", follow the NEW CHIP VERSION instructions. If the terminal displays: "DAY OF THE WEEK=", follow the OLD CHIP VERSION instructions.

## Latest Chip Version:

- Press the 3 and $*$ key at the same time. Terminal will say DIAGNOSTICS
- Press the ALPHA key. Terminal will say YEAR=, Key in 4 digit year.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say MONTH=, Key in 2 digits for the month.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say DAY=, Key in 2 digits for the day.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say HOUR $(0-23)=$, Key in 2 digits for hour in Military Time.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say MINUTES=. Key in 2 digits for the minute.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say SECONDS=. Key in 2 digits for the seconds.
- Press ENTER to get back to the main display.


## Older Chip Version:

You cannot put the year 2000+ on an old chip version terminal. The year will have to be stored as 19XX. This does not change how the terminal operates. It will just show the wrong year on a printed receipt.

- Press [3] and [ $*$ ] key at the same time. Terminal will DIAGNOSTICS
- Press the ALPHA key. Terminal will say DAY OF WEEK=. Key in 0= Sunday, 1=Monday, 2=Tuesday. 3=Wednesday, 4=Thursday, 5=Friday, 6=Saturday.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say YEAR=19__. Press last 2 digits for the current year
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say MONTH=. Press 2 digits for the month.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say DATE=. Press 2 digits for the date.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say HOUR=. Press 2 digits for the hour.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say $\mathrm{AM}=0, \mathrm{PM}=1$. Press appropriate number.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say MINUTES=. Press 2 digits for the minutes.
- Press ENTER. Terminal will say SECONDS=. Press 2 digits for the seconds.
- Press ENTER to get back to the main display.
